Matters for information only:

- 2. Incidents of golf balls being struck at the Sports Field are increasing. This is an extremely dangerous practice, particularly as the facility is shared space.

Report from PCSO:

Matters relating to September agenda:

24/109 Vacancy for Parish Councillor

An interview took place on the 9th September via Zoom. The Clerk circulated notes to members on the 10th September with recommendations.

Correspondence received:

- Email received about an inconsiderate parking on the pavement on Fieldway Rd mainly vans and large vehicles, and inconsiderate parking on the payment around the village.
- 2. Email received about residential properties owners not maintaining their hedges and vegetation which causes obstruction.
- 3. Email received about continuous power cuts and what is the parish council doing about it or communicating it to the community. The resident who has raised this issue produced a basic spreadsheet and have been recording all the power cuts including shortcuts over this past year and there was around about 20. Most of them are shortcuts which are less than 5 minutes (most less than a 1 minute) and problems reporting them to UK power networks as they don't recognise a shortcut as a power incident. WPC is asked to write to the UK Power Network and also liase with the MP about the ongoing issue.
